COMMENTARY: As Steve has left for the New York International show, it is left to me to write a commentary this month. This list is the second in a series of lists that we plan for coins from Bill Spengler's fine collection of mainly Indian coins but including some Islamic and modern world coins. We hope to produce two or three more lists that would cover the remainder of Bill's collection. They will likely come out every three months or so as Steve and I work through more of Bill's coins. There are still several thousand coins that remain to be listed including the medieval Indian coins. Steve and I traveled to Europe a few months ago to purchase a large collection of modern (17-20th Century) Islamic coins, which covers Morocco through Afghanistan. There are thousands of coins in the collection with an emphasis on Ottoman issues from Algeria to Turkey. I have just begun working on this collection while Steve works on Islamic coins in the office that have been sitting around unattributed; some for years. The first list we plan to produce that would include coins from this remarkable collection should be out in March if not sooner. Doug Nicol has also begun helping us out again by working on the backlog of coins that need attribution and cataloging.

Most of you have undoubtedly noticed, the metals market has been extraordinarily active over the past couple of months with gold hitting a 25-year high yesterday at \$553.00 per ounce. According to MarketWatch, "last weeks' announcement that China will diversify its holdings of foreign [currency] reserves has put pressure on the dollar and provided support for gold." It seems that China is lessening its dependence on the dollar and buying up more gold for its national reserves. This will likely force the US and Europeans to follow suit and buy gold after decades of gold dumping. Silver has broken the \$9.00 per ounce point today and it, along with palladium, platinum and even copper, seem poised for more upward movement. We haven't seen this much activity in the metals markets since the Hunt brother's fiasco in 1979-80, but unlike then, this market is not as heavily influenced by western speculators as by Asian free market and governmental demand. The big question is how high will it go during this bull market? That depends on a plethora of complex, seemingly unrelated crisis.

One is the H5N1 avian influenza virus that we have all been reading so much about lately. If it were to mutate into a virus easily passed human to human as in the 1918 pandemic, the World Bank estimates the cost to the global economy could be US\$800 billion a year and likely trigger another worldwide recession. Time to stock up on Tamiflu?

Another factor in the skyrocketing price of gold and silver is that it is difficult for many dealers and most collectors, including us, to adjust in our minds to the higher and ever changing prices of individual coins. Best just to keep a calculator handy and check metals prices frequently on the Internet. We recommend www.xe.com/ucc, just type in the metal you'd like to check prices on under the heading "into this type of currency." **Joe**
