Commentary: *China trip continued...* After a couple of days in Xi'an, Roger, Jim, myself and several other Chinese numismatists traveled to Ürümqi (Wulumuqi in Chinese), the capital of Xinjiang Province. As Steve mentioned last year, Ürümqi is a very modern city with enumerable skyscrapers and shopping malls. The Grand Bazaar downtown is fascinating if not a bit too tourist-oriented. It seemed to be located in the heart of the Uyghur section of town as even some of the police we encountered around the bazaar seemed not to read or speak Chinese proficiently. Wulumuqi is the capital of the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region although now it is a thoroughly Han Chinese city with the Uyghurs in the minority along with the Hui, Kazak, Mongolian, Kirgiz, Russian and Xibe. It seemed to me, with few exceptions, that the Chinese and Uyghur communities mix very little, and in most areas of Wulumuqi the signs are posted only in Chinese or English, the Uyghur language nowhere to be found. More on the disparities between the Han and Uyghur communities in Xinjiang later. There is little sightseeing to do in Wulumuqi, but the Xinjiang Regional Museum in Urumqi was definitely worth seeing. It was closed while Steve visited, as the old Soviet era building had just been demolished and the construction had yet to be completed on the new building. All the staff at the museum I spoke with seemed to miss the old building but having not seen it myself, I thought the new one very nice indeed. The displays, particularly of ancient mummies and the clothes they wore were fascinating. Our English speaking guide was a treat as well, for she was, if I recall correctly, a mix of Uzbek, Tartar, Russian, and Chinese. She was wonderful, telling stories and joking throughout the museum. Her expertise was in ancient fabrics and with the dry climate in Xinjiang, a treasure trove of these items have been found there over the past several decades. I did find a small coin market in Wulumuqi but it had little to offer. One dealer there was kind enough to show Jim and I his personal collection of Sinkiang struck silver and bronze coins which included some lovely pieces.

While in Ürümqi our party journeyed by bus to Turfan (Turpan in Uyghur and Tulufan in Chinese) where the local archeological society treated us like royalty. The first day we saw the lovely Emin minaret and the ruins of Jiaohe, a prefectural seat of the Gaochang Kingdom during the Tang dynasty. The city never recovered from the Mongol invasions of the 13th century; it is now a UNESCO World Heritage site. The second day, we traveled to the Flaming Mountains and visited the Bezeklik Thousand Buddha Caves. The seventy or so caves date from the 5th to the 9th centuries and unfortunately between over zealous Muslims and early 20th century European 'archeologists', little remains of their former beauty. In the afternoon we visited the ancient capital of the Gaochang Kingdom. Gaochang (Qara-hoja in Uyghur) was founded in the 1st century BC and became an important site along the Silk Road. We were told that a Mongol army of 150,000 besieged the city for a 18 months until its fall in the 13th century, from which it never recovered. Today, it has become a Disneyland type attraction where donkey carts packed with tourists ply the ancient main road of the city and hawkers have taken over the entrance gate at the massive ancient city wall. We were lucky enough to see extremely rare genuine Gaochang cash type coins in the museum in Turfan as well as many imitative Byzantine gold coins used for burial. We returned to Ürümqi the morning after the archeology and antiquities folks gave us a wonderful Uyghur style Chinese banquet.

From Ürümqi Jim and I flew to Kashgar (Kashi in Chinese) which was what both Jim and I expected to find in this remote corner of China. The huge Id Kah Mosque, the largest mosque in China, dominates the heart of the city. The mosque was built by Shakesimirzha in 1422 and I was told it could hold 10,000 people on Friday night prayers. The mosque was at the center of a sharp rise in tension between the Uyghurs and the local Han Chinese in 2003 when developers razed a rose garden on the mosque site and built an enclosed market next door. It was next to this enclosed market, which sold mostly tourist items, that Jim and I had our first experience with radical Islam. We entered a bookstore only to discover that it was a religious bookstore which one would expect next to a large mosque, but as we perused around we noticed a video was playing on the TV above. The program that was showing happened to be subtitled in English and it was espousing the most hate-filled anti-Western rhetoric that I have ever heard. As we turned to exit the shop, we noticed the only way out of this small store was blocked by Uyghur men in conservative dress who were watching the video. Although we had no trouble exiting the store, it was still a disquieting experience. Many men in Kashgar still keep long beards and wear traditional clothing and many women still wear a local type of brown cloth veil that completely covers the head. One site that is not to be missed is the *mazar* of Abakh Khoja, located at the edge of town and considered the holiest Muslim site in Xinjiang. This lovely tiled mausoleum was built in the 17th century and contains the tombs of five generations of his family. Abakh was a powerful ruler, controlling Khotan, Yarkand, Korla, Kucha and Aksu as well as Kashgar. Among some Uyghur Muslims, he was considered a prophet, second only to Mohammad in importance.

The Han Chinese are clearly a minority in Kashgar, with the Chinese living mostly in their own area separate from local Uyghurs. Separate, but most definitely not equal, nearly all the nicer shops, be they, clothing, electronics, luggage, even hotels & restaurants seemed to be owned and operated by Chinese. The Uyghur shops sell mostly local handicrafts, local food (mutton, grapes and *naan*) or local music and books. The money all over Xinjiang appeared to be concentrated among the Chinese who now make up 41% of the provincial population, most being concentrated in Wulumuqi. All the beggars and most of the poor I encountered in Xinjiang were Uyghurs. The general disparity between the growing wealthy class and the poor seems to be growing wider, and it

seems to me that unless there is more growth of a middle class in China, the country may once again be headed for political instability. This disparity in Xinjiang and the growing influence of radical Islam among the dispossessed could lead to major trouble for the PRC government in the future.

After leaving Kashgar we backtracked the same way to Hong Kong (skipping Xi'an) and then departed Hong Kong for San Francisco thus ending quite a trip.... Joe
