1821	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – The attribution to Kishangarh or Jaipur remains unresolved.
1869	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – The word on the top of the reverse is "sobha", which means "magnificent", an extremely rare issue minted at Amritsar, known dated VS1841 and 1843, and not until very recently recognized as a significant separate type -- this recently published by Gurprit Singh as #01.07.02
