LOT #	CORRECTIONS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION / WITHDRAWN LOTS
65	CORRECTION – Mint is AT (Adharbayjan), not ST (Istakhr). Extremely rare for this one-year type. Estimated value is \$250 to \$350
127	CORRECTION – AV (mistyped as AR in printed catalog)
143	CORRECTION – Bactrian BAXLO in place of mint name on reverse. (<i>New research by Stefan Heidemann shows that the word is BAXLO for the city of Balkh, not ALXON, published in Numismatic Chronicle, v. 175 (2015), pp. 330-344.</i>)
206	CORRECTION – Rarity is only R, not RRR. “Qasr al-Salam operated only AH167-169, with 167 & 168 relatively available.”
266	CORRECTION – Mint is al-Andalus, not Madinat al-Zahra
505	CORRECTION – Coin is not silver. It is struck in bronze or billon, with silver wash.
511	CORRECTION – Date is AH784, with the “4” unclear. (It is not AH782).
618	CORRECTION – Hairline flan crack (not mentioned in printed catalog).

1098	CORRECTION – Type is Sieg-45.4, coin is Scarce but not rare, and grade is VG not Fine
1120	CORRECTION – Type is KM- 653.1 (Napoleon as Premier Consul)
1129	CORRECTION – MAZ-795 (silver)
1173	CORRECTION – Grade is MS64 (NGC)
1177	CORRECTION – Grade is Brilliant UNC (not graded by NGC)
1246	CORRECTION – Grade is MS63

1401	CORRECTION – crowned & winged siren
1403	CORRECTION – Dragon to left with open mouth, uncertain creature with wings and a crown above; only 42 coins total known and only 13 in private collection per Gaidukov.
1407	CORRECTION – with text around; Master Alexandro (worked with Ornistoteles)
1410	CORRECTION – Novgorod mint
1411	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – legend “Denga Zamamina”, very rare type
1418	CORRECTION – struck by the Swedish Master Nefedka in 1617; type G/K-709
1425	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – Unlisted type in Trotsyanski catalog
1426	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – Unlisted type A7.1 R7.3
1427	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – Only 4 reported examples of this coin have appeared, Trostyanski 18.9 Type V #10/7

1903	UPDATED DESCRIPTON - MUGHAL: LOT of 18 silver and 1 copper coin, rupee unless noted: Farrukhsiyar: Surat, Shahjahanabad; Rafi-ud-Darjat: Zain al-'Abidin Ahmadabad, year one (EF, but some hornsilver at the rim); Jahandar Shah: Khujista Bunyad year one (VG); Muhammad Shah: 10 common rupees and 3 half rupees of Surat; Alamgir II: Surat; and Shah Alam II: mintless copper dam, year 31, assigned to the Punjab region; retail value \$480, lot of 19 pieces
