331	UPDATED DESCRIPTION – SULAYHID: abú Kámil ad-Dá'í `Alí, late 11th century, AV dinar (2.42g), `Aththar, AH(45)9 (probably frozen). A-1075.2. Zeno-188472. With his title tentative read as al-'Adil al Kamil in place of Sharaf al-Ma'ali, VF, RRR. Struck only at 'Aththar, with frozen date (45)9, citing Najjah in the reverse field, although uncertain whether this Najjah is related to the Sunni Najjahid dynasty. <i>Thanks to Vladimir Suchy for his attention to this lot.</i>
