International postal money orders are recommended for smaller amounts. Payments may be made to my overseas accounts (details below)

Fifteen-day return privilege for any reason. Payments due 15 days after invoice date.



COMMENTARY (10 July 1994) — June slipped by without a list, what with Long Beach, New York, and a short holiday around northern California with Stefan Heidemann. I've probably been spending too much time on the trail, out on Mount Tamalpais or in Armstrong Redwoods State Park, and too little time with coins. Now the paper has served his bill, and I am making up for lost time. Therefore I will have this list in the post in a few days, and will do regular monthly lists from now until November, skipping December as usual.

Doug Nicol is away for most of the month of July, pursuing research and family roots in England and Scotland. He is proceeding with his comprehensive catalog of the Fatimid coinage, and several of us have challenged him to get the manuscript finished by the end of 1996. I'm publishing this here because I really want Doug to finish the work and get it out for publication before we all go to our graves, and I am once more optimistic that he'll do it.

About 70% of the present list consists of coins not previously listed. Many of the remaining 30% are relisted at reduced prices. This is about average for my non-photo lists. There are a few special groupings on this list, including a few nice Umayyad coppers, a large group of outstanding later Safavid and Qajar silver coins, a fine run of coins of Jahandar (mostly relisted from previous lists), and many Indian princely states. I will follow this list with another non-photo list in August and a photo list in September.

I currently have available an outstanding collection of Mughal copper coins, over 1000 different, with a strong showing of emperors other than Akbar and many rare mints and types. The collection will be offered first intact, then broken up if there is no interest in the entirety. A list of this collection should be available shortly. Ask for a copy if interested.
