**COMMENTARY** (2 December 1994) — Beginning 1 January 1995, there will be an increase in postal rates in the United States, with a domestic first class letter to cost 32¢, still cheap compared to most industrialized countries. Other domestic rates will rise about 10% across the board, foreign rates to be announced later this month. So after more than three years, I shall also increase my postal charges to reflect the new rates.

What is hard to understand is that a simple airmail letter from the US to Germany now costs 50¢ (probably to rise to 55¢), but sent from Germany to the US, the same letter costs DM3, currently \$1.91, or nearly four times what we pay. Any ideas?

If I had more space, I could write pages on the Republican landslide in the November 8 elections here. A lifelong Democrat, son of Democrat parents, I was appalled at the disaster. But upon reflection, I am beginning to understand how the Democratic party, both at the national and state levels, has failed to promote and carry through an agenda that would lend the perception that problems are being addressed and resolved. Hence the stampede to the other party, a process that has little to with either party, but is rather a comment on the seeming intractability of the problems we now face. The stampede could thus easily reverse itself in 1996, as the Republicans seem to have no better answers to problems that I believe to be global in nature, part of a major social and political shift following the end of the Cold War and the internationalization of the world economy. Perhaps a major realignment of the political parties is in the offing, perhaps even the formation of viable third parties on the order of Ross Perot's populist horde. More on this later!
