COMMENTARY (12 January 1995) — Until now, it has always been I who made the selection of which coins to place on a list. For the first time, Doug made the selection, and honestly, I think he's done a much better job than I could have done myself. Pulling the coins has always been a stumbling block for me, a task I detest, and thus could never do properly. Of course, the bottom line remains, will Doug's selection sell more coins than mine?

Most of you have probably by now heard about the floods that struck California over the past week. Here in Sonoma County we have had some terrible floods, with some areas still underwater since Sunday (the 8th), and more rain expected over the weekend. Fortunately, here in Santa Rosa, just about everyone remains high and dry, for nobody here has been foolish enough to build (illegally, at that!) in the flood plain. The same is not true along the Russian River, which rose from 14 feet to 49 feet at Guerneville (17 feet above flood stage) in the space of just under 48 hours. At one point, the river was rising at the rate of two feet per hour (one centimeter per minute), with the result that hundreds of people had to be rescued from their roofs or out of trees. The Russian River drains a large watershed area, which narrows down to a canyon, through which all the water has to pass. Thus it rises faster than any other river in the western hemisphere. But it is also one of the most beautiful places to live in the US. Most of the residents are happy to stay, and endure the occasional flood. No wonder Buck's Ranch built a boat ramp and an upstairs bar to serve people during times of flood!
