**COMMENTARY** (12 March 1995) — Once again, somebody pulled the plug on the great bathtub in the sky, right over California. Here in Sonoma County, the rains were not particularly disastrous. The Russian River crested *only* ten feet above flood stage, though it rose and receded much faster than in January's floods. Further south, unfortunately, the situation was far more serious, especially in Monterey, San Luis Obispo, and Santa Barbara counties, where damage was extensive, despite the sparse population of that region.
