**COMMENTARY** (14 May 1995) — It takes less time to add coins to the list than to contemplate exalted logorrhea for the hot air page. Since I am rather rushed, I will eschew any attempt at eloquence this month. The house move is coming along, with the expected few hitches, and with slower progress than hoped for. The office is more or less back in normal shape, with a few temporary arrangements. The normal list schedule can now be resumed.

The New York show earlier this month was rather a bore, with little to buy and few opportunities to sell. It seems that new horde material is slowly drying up, as coins more readily accessible to metal detectors have already largely been found. Still, there is plenty on the market, and some new areas are opening up, such as the former Soviet Union. Expect some interesting material from Caucasia and Central Asia in the next few years, though current offerings tend to be mostly lower end material.
