

**COMMENTARY** (1 January 1996) — It may be January, but I'm still going to call this the December list. The unpleasantly virulent form of influenza that is coursing through California at this time laid me low for much of the last two weeks, taking away all incentive to get this list done in time to post it before year's end. The flu is gone, and with it most of the associated headcold, and good riddance.

Formally speaking, today marks my twentieth anniversary as a coin dealer, though I had informally been dealing for a few months before that. How numismatics have changed over the past 20 years! Back in 1976, most demand for Islamic and Indian coins was in Europe and America, with relatively little interest in the source countries. Most better coins were shipped straight to the West, with New York the leading emporium. Only the modern series commanded serious prices: medieval coins were cheap, silver rarely costing over \$50 gold rarely more than a few hundred for even the greatest of rarities. There were exceptions, such as Islamic presentation pieces or the zodiac mohurs of Jahangir, but they were few, and demand for them was relatively thin. The typical collector collected everything available. There were few specialists, and prices were so low that finding enough to buy was often more difficult than spending all one's funds. And there was less to buy, so that specialization made little sense. There was little of an international market, and no mail order dealers concentrating on these areas, though some dealers were already offering nice selections. Before Sotheby's began their Islamic coin sales in 1978, hardly any such coins came to auction, most often in lots, as individual pieces were too low-priced to merit an individual listing. Competition amongst collectors, nonetheless, was fiercer than today, but that rivalry had not yet transmuted itself into higher prices, except for the already more developed market for machine-struck coins. And in 1976, we, the numismatic fraternity, were just getting used to the Krause-Mishler catalog, though it was a far cry from the relatively sophisticated endeavor it has subsequently become. More later!
