COMMENTARY (15 May 1997) — I was recently asked to explain why sometimes I use round parentheses () or square brackets [] around mints or dates (or portions thereof). Here is the convention: Round parentheses indicate portions of the inscription that are not visible on the particular specimen but known to have been engraved in the die, usually because they are off the flan or because a part of the coin is worn or corroded. Square brackets indicate portions that are not on the die, but which is assumed from other sources. And with dates, the use of the letter "x" for one or more digits indicates portions not visible and not reconstructable.

Currently I have been researching the coinage of the Qarakhanids, with the intention to putting together a more accurate listing for the second edition of the *Checklist*. There have been dozens of articles published in Russian in the past 25-30 years, with important contributions by Davidovich, Fedorov, and especially Kochnev, who has taken up the challenge to elucidate the coinage and history of their very complex dynasty. I also anticipate that more specimens will be showing up in the market in the next few years, so I want to be ready for them. Relearning Russian at Oxford last fall is now paying off.

There is good news from Tübingen. At least three more volumes of the *Sylloge* should be published in the next twelve months. The first will cover just the mint of Hamah in Syria (over 700 coins!). Another will treat northern Khorasan, of which the principal mint is Balkh. The third will treat about half of Transoxania (with the other half to come out in another year or so). All of this activity has been financed by an academic grant. I'll keep you posted.

Summery weather has been with us here for a couple weeks already. There was heavy rain and some serious flooding in December and January, but since the first few days of February, only a few light showers have occurred. Now we are into the dry season (also called the fire season!), sunny days most of the time, with some marine fog coming in from time to time to cool things down.
