

COMMENTARY (14 May 1999) — I'm back in California for a short sojourn, mainly to prepare some lists and to finish the usual accounting work that all businessmen must suffer. I leave California early on the morning of 28 May, returning to Oxford the following morning.

This list is somewhat unusual in that almost all the coins are relists from previous lists. As a result I am offering a special discount. For any filled order of eight or more coins, please take 10% discount, and for any filled order of 15 or more coins, take 15% discount.

There are a few previously unlisted coins, including a few better princely states and all of the Iranian and Central Asian coins after 1400. The discount will apply to these as well.

The first volume of the Oxford *Sylloge Numorum Arabicorum* is nearly completed and should be sent to the printers around the middle of June, providing there are no further glitches. That volume will include 735± coins from Arabia and East Africa, including the largest variety of pre-modern East African coinage ever assembled in a single location. Many new attributions are provided as well. The second volume, hopefully to the printer in late August or early September, will cover the coinage of Iran and Afghanistan from the Mongols to the end of hammered coinage, comprising about 1825 pieces. Tentative prices should be in the range of \$55-65 for the first volume, \$90-100 for the second. We should have definite prices for both by the end of June. I expect the first volume to be ready for shipment in early August, the second in October or November.
