I expect to finish the Arab-Sasanian volume of SICA (together with Tony Goodwin, who is handling the Arab-Byzantine material in the same volume) and complete the initial assembly of the volume on Spain and North Africa, for publication in early 2002. Doug Nicol will be there together with me putting together the rather large volume on the five dynasties of Egypt and Syria (Tulunis, Ikshidid, Fatimid, Ayyubid and Mamluk), also for publication in 2002.
