COMMENTARY (28 August 2001) — As I am overwhelmed with far too many obligations, there will be little commentary. I should mention that Joe has been with me now for just over a month, and things are working out superbly well, despite my occasion anxiety.

We are changed the domestic postage rates. For all normal coin orders, the postage is \$2 for orders up to \$100, \$5 for all larger ones, including insurance. The only exception will be very heavy shipments, where full postage & insurance will be charged. All foreign orders will be charged the amount of postage, insurance and or registration. This will make things simpler for us and more in line with normal business procedures in the modern age.
