**COMMENTARY** (February 25th 2002) — The past month has been rather exciting. Not only have I purchased more than fifty kilos of new acquisitions, but I was also able to complete the text of Volume 1 of the Sylloge of Islamic Coins in the Ashmolean, covering Arab-Sasanian (my portion) and Arab-Byzantine (done by Tony Goodwin). I just spoke to the editor-in-chief, Luke Treadwell, and he anticipates handing over the completed text to the printers later this week. I will be going back once more for three months in Oxford, approximately May 1st to July 31st this year, in order to complete Sylloge volume #5, covering Islamic coins of Spain & North Africa. Joe will keep the office open while I'm away. Doug Nicol is currently well along with finalizing volume #6, Egypt & Syria, which should be out by the end of this year or early in 2003. I will also be putting together the Sylloge of a major privately owned collection of about 700 different Arab-Sasanian coins, the largest collection yet to be published. It is likely that after of August 1st I will no longer be devoting such masses of time to writing numismatic books!
