**COMMENTARY:** We are now filing our better coins in 2x2 plastic flips, with printed tickets appearing more professional than hand-written envelopes that we have been using for more than 30 years. Inexpen-

sive coins will continue to be placed in the quick-to-write envelopes. The plastic flips are reasonably safe but should not be maintained for more than a few years. Inert mylar flips can be purchased from all suppliers of numismatic equipment, but they tend to be brittle and must be carefully handled, lest they split apart. However, under careful handling they should last for many many decades without any noticeable deterioration. I highly recommend that any coins purchased from us in flips be transferred to a safer holder, be it a paper envelope, a safe flip, a horizontal tray, etc.

The week before last I was down in Sydney, Australia, examining and arranging a large collection of Mughal and Indian Princely State (IPS) coins. During that effort I found myself confused about what should be the best means of organizing those coins in catalogs. There are two complex matters: (1) Since nearly all of the early IPS coins and many of the early European colonial coins retain traditional Mughal designs and inscriptions, how can we conclude whether they are Mughal, IPS or colonial issues? (2) Should separate mints producing clearly distinctive coinage with a single IPS be listed under the appropriate state, as is now practiced in the KM catalogs for nearly all locations, or should they be listed separately by mint?

The first issue is rather more complex, for the collapse of the Mughal empire, which commenced during the last years of Aurangzeb as the result of the rise of the Marathas (circa 1105 AH, 1695 AD). By the time of the accession of Ahmad Shah Bahadur in 1161/1749, the Mughal principality could hardly be regarded as an empire. Nonetheless, dozens of independent and quasi-independent states throughout India continued to strike coins in the name of the current—occasionally the deceased, Mughal emperor—usually with nothing more than a symbol or two to represent the local ruler. Even the British E.I.C. followed this policy, striking coins for decades in the name of a present or former emperor, usually with a frozen date. Ideally, once a particular mint can be determined to have more or less escaped Mughal authority, they the coins of that mint should be listed separately. Unfortunately, this process requires a great deal of research. Perhaps a simple method, at least before all the appropriate research could be undertaken for a more accurate categorization, would be to consider all coins through Muhammad Shah (1131-1161/1719-1748) as purely Mughal, and all subsequent coins, save those of the capital Shahjahanabd (=Delhi), as issues of the appropriate mint.

The second matter concerns the present method used by KM to organize the non-colonial and non-Mughal Indian coins. Personally I disagree with their assumption that the multiplicity of states should be divided into two separate group of "independent kingdoms" and one series of "Indian princely states". There is no reason to regard these categories as distinctive political entities. They should all be alphabetical in a single listing.

More confusing is the organizing of multiple mints under a separate state or kingdom. For examples, the several dozen mints producing coins under the Marathas were not separate mints of a single coinage, but rather in nearly all cases producers of a local coinage (albeit with difficult complexity). It is well known from Princesps and other early 19th century economic scholars who examined the circulation of Indian coins that nearby mints very frequently produced coins of slightly different weight and significantly different silver content. Coins of different Maratha mints could thus not be counted as a fixed group, but had to be sorted by mint issues (in some cases even subordinate issues of individual mints) and evaluated according to mint attribution. For this reason it makes sense to list the mints as separate entities. But often the same mint will operate under different authorities: For example, Ahmadabad was a normal Mughal mint until the end of the reign of Muhammad Shah and in the first couple of years of Ahmad Shah. It then became a Maratha mint (coins identified by the ankus) from AH 1165-1207, leased to Baroda 1207-1225, then part of Baroda 1225-1233, then under the British until it was finally closed down in 1255. Would it not make more sense to list all the Ahmadabad coins together, as least all the pre-British coins, with perhaps the British group transferred to the British listings? And the same for all the many mints that were under Marathas, Rohilkhands, Awadh, Gwalior, etc., etc. And all arranged in the catalog by alphabetical order, with brief cross-reference notes as required.

If anyone has comments about this matter, I would be interested in hearing their thoughts. And I should also be interested in hearing anyone's comments on the new format introduced in the 30th edition of the 20th century KM catalog, eventually to be adopted for all volumes.
