COMMENTARY: We have had to issue a non-photo list for #185, as we are still learning the use & production of digital photography and Adobe Photo-Shop Elements, with Joe advancing far more rapidly than I am. List 186 will almost certainly be out next photo list, and will be quite differently organized than our previous ones.

Last Thursday we had about 1/4 inch of snow here in Santa Rosa, the first I've seen here in many years.
