**COMMENTARY:** Both Joe and I have been highly pleased by the wonderful comments we have received about our last photo list (#192) and the last larger non-photo list (#191). The paper and printing quality of list #192 was surprising good (the relatively low photo contrast was due to our software here, not the printer's fault). We had the lists printed in Bangalore, India, and sent here by FedEx air, the entire process was considerably more affordable than our previous San Jose printing. We will continue to have the non-photo lists printed here in Santa Rosa, the photo lists in Bangalore, hopefully four large non-photo, two or three small non-photo, and four photo lists annually. And to ease the entire process, we anticipate computerizing our inventory over the next couple of years.

I have received a payment of €215 to my Tübingen account on July 7<sup>th</sup> from account number 1029437, but there was no payer's name or invoice number. Is this yours? If so, please let me know. I cannot apply a payment to anyone's account unless they include their name with the payment (and if possible, the invoice number as well). When making payments, we also kindly request that customers refrain from using third parties to pay bills for them. This often causes accounting irregularities to occur. We now accept credit cards and VISA check cards for payment which should help our overseas customers in making payments (Steve admits to having finally moved into the late 20<sup>th</sup> century, not quite yet the 21<sup>st</sup>).

Many of you ask us to scan coins from our stock or lists. Due to the time and effort it takes to scan, manipulate and save the image, we will have to limit scanned items to those with a value of \$50 or higher. Thanks for your understanding. Steve
