PAYPAL: To pay, you must have a PayPal account yourself (you can open your free account at www.paypal.com). Then you need only type my email address (album@sonic.net) and the amount you owe me.

BIDPAY: To pay, you must have a Bidpay account yourself (you can open your free account at www.bidpay.com).

CREDIT CARDS: VISA & Mastercard accepted as well as VISA check cards. Please supply the address to which the card is billed and the expiration date.

The results have been that, in the first case, we sent you the wrong coin, or in the second case, that we told you, especially on the phone, that an item was still available when in fact it had been sold. We offer our apologies to all those who either received the wrong coin or were incorrectly told that an item was still available. Our computer "guru" is currently trying to resolve these mistakes. Please bare with us on this list #208, as the inventory corrections are still in progress. Now that we are aware of the problems, we try our best to avoid these misrepresentations.

Beginning with this list, our invoices will show BOTH the item number (in our database) and the lot number (on the priceless), at least for coins in #208 and subsequent lists.

3rd note on China: After returning from Kashgar, we spent two days in Turfan, which is connected to Urumqi by a modern toll road, two lanes each way, with several toll booths along the way, some 250 km in all. The authorities are very cleverly enforcing the speed limit, using both modern cameras and the old fashioned method, measuring your speed by the time printed on the ticket from the previous toll booth. Sure enough, our driver was caught at the toll booth, and hit with a hefty fine. For me, this was a wonderful reminder of how my father received a speeding ticket on the New Jersey Turnpike almost 50 years ago.

On the afternoon of my first day in Turfan I had several free hours, which is used for a long walk and a visit to the 18th century Emin Mosque, an awesome structure, whose simplicity and beauty are miraculous. I walked though many of the older traditional neighborhoods, and was impressed by the city. Roger, Wang and I spent the second day visiting several local archaeological sites, such as Jiaohe, Karez, Gaochang, Bezeklik, etc., including the small site near Sanpu, where the local archaeologists have begun new investigations. We returned to Turfan well after dark, then enjoyed yet another delicious banquet. We had intended to remain overnight at Turfan, but as the weather forecast predicted serious sandstorms for the next two days, we drove back that evening to Urumqi, this type observing the speed limit, returning at the Hoi Kan hotel at about 1:30 AM. Ironically, the sandstorms never reached the Turfan region.

The following day we visited a local collector of Xinjiang coinage, an impressive collection, unfortunately not for sale. On the next day I had many hours free to wonder on my own throughout the city of Urumqi. I quickly determined the convenience of the city bus system, with the free hotel map indicating most of the local bus lines. I found all sorts of interesting locations, including what is perhaps the only surviving significant section of the old city, which appears to be under some sort of protection for eventual preservation, perhaps as a tourist site for the increasing number of Chinese and foreign tourists visiting the city. And then there is the Gelende Hotel---yes, Gelende is simply the anglicization of the Chinese pronunciation of Holiday---oddly located in the middle of a 1980s blue collar government housing development known as Erdaowan Village. The hotel restaurant is called Natasha Discoteka and is signed in Russian, announcing that their cuisine comprises Russian shashlik and Brazilian steak. Obviously, internationalization has struck Urumqi as well.

The following day, the Sanpu archaeologist showed up at the Hoi Kan Hotel with his latest finds, a uniface jewelry imitation of a Byzantine solidus of Constantine IV and an attractive Sasanian drachm of Queen Boran, Sijistan mint (SK), year two. These coins were presumably placed alongside corpses buried in the cemetery where the archaeologists were digging.
