"For the times, they are a'changin'," and this means that it is not so far in the future that we will abandon the printed version of the non-photo pricelists, to be replaced at first by a pricelist sent only by e-mail, then perhaps solely by uploading our recent purchases directly onto the website.

As for the printed version of the photo lists, we still intend to continue issuing them well into the future.

**COMMENTARY:** A year ago who would have imagined that gold would be selling for \$587 per ounce and silver at \$11.70 per ounce (current prices as I am typing this paragraph), and increase of between 40% and 50% over the past year or two. While this has a rather minimal direct effect on rare coins, it certainly has effected coins whose retail prices are only several times their metal values, whether they be modern or old. Of course, for the collector selling off his cheaper gold coins, this is an unpredicted gift!

At the same time there has been a substantial increase in auction prices and in the percentage of auction lots that are actually sold. Moreover, "slabbing" coins is no longer restricted to coins of the United States and Canada. At the Chicago International Coin Fair last week, I observed that a few dealers were primarily offering slabbed world coins; dealers that until recently would not have dealt much in slabbed coins. Even ancient and medieval coins are showing up in slabs, to the horror of traditional numismatists. One dealer confirmed that his principal interest was to acquire coins and have them slabbed, hoping that it will be graded so high that its profitability will become substantially greater. For this reason he was unwilling to sell his best coins until they were slabbed. This remained me of the US coin market in the late '80s and early '90s, when coins were bought "raw" (not yet slapped), then sent in to be slapped. If unsatisfied with the grade, a dealer would often "crack" it out of the slap, then "resubmit" the item again, anticipating a higher grade for the same specimen. The difference in price between an MS-65 and MS-66 for a particular coin could be ten-fold and thus reap the dealer a huge windfall profit if the coin came back with the higher grade.

Is this direction in which the world coin and ancient coin markets are treading? Much as I detest the concept of slabbing coins, I fear that slabbing is a growing feature that is here to stay. Once again, the activities at CICF tended to substantiate this observation several dealers inspected our stock looking for coins that would command a better price if slabbed. So whether we like it or not, it seems the times are indeed a'changin'. There is one other aspect of slapping, and that is an inexpensive insurance policy should the coin later prove to be fake, for the major grading companies both grade and authenticate a coin, and will stand by their authentication. Should adequate evidence later prove that the coin is indeed a fake, the major grading company will buy the coin back.
