COMMENTARY: What in the world is transpiring? Less than two months ago I reported gold at \$587 and silver at \$11.70, where today (10 May) they closed at \$707 and \$14.39, respectively, up yet another 20% and 23%. Were one to factor the average gold & silver prices since the US legalized general possession of gold in January 1975, the current prices will surely exceed the average prices over those 31 years but not excessively. Thus to some extent, the current increases were a "catch-up" to traditional market prices. Amongst the responsible factors would be (1) the decline in mining, as the effective decline in silver and gold prices between 1980 and 2004, as well as increasing environmental regulations, have lessened the profitability of mining, (2) the phenomenal economic growth and resultant affordability of luxury items such as jewelry and tableware in emerging nations, especially China and India, and (3) the recent interest in precious metal investments amongst American and other hedge funds.

Last week I attended Baldwin's auction #45 in London. The morning session comprised over 400 lots of Indian coins (ancient to modern) plus a remarkable selection of British colonial coins, 18th-20th century. Frequently, especially for coins in better conditions, the buyer's price sailed above the heavens. Only the rare Kushan and Gupta gold coins failed to sell, with a few exceptions. In all, about 15% remained unsold, primarily rather common coins with outlandish estimates, or when the reserve price exceeded the minimum estimate. The wildest bidding characterized the East Indian Company (EIC) issues, especially the silver patterns, which fetched between 4 and 10 times the estimate. Only a few of the 88 EIC lots failed to sell, most notoriously the 1941 pattern dollar of George IV, estimate at £12000-£15000, perhaps obscenely above reality. Interestingly, there was not a single bidder jacking up the prices, but spirited bidding from both collectors and dealers.

I recently spent 10 days in London and Paris, spending more money than ever during a European buying trip (but including three days escape to Oxford and Charlbury). Amongst my purchases were more than 110 relatively common gold mohurs, which will be appearing on our next lists. Also a lovely group of Ayyubid silver, some excellent Artuqid & Zangid coins, some Abbasid silver, and lots more that I can't even remember.
