

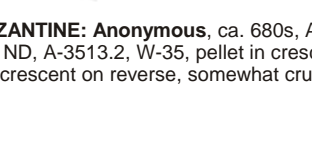

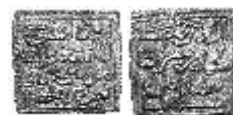

Commentary: China trip continued - After our pleasant evening in Zhuhai, Roger, Jim, myself and a Chinese dealer left in the morning by bus to Guangzhou (Canton). The nearly three hour ride took us through much of the countryside where farms and fields predominated the environment. After seeing firsthand how chickens and geese are raised in China it is no wonder how bird flu first got its chance to spread so rapidly across the globe. In Hong Kong, there was such fear of avian influenza that even the local McDonald's outlets pushed the fact that all their chickens come from the United States and all are approved by the US Department of Agriculture. Also, when entering Hong Kong, you are scanned for your internal temperature, if you have a fever, you are whisked away by a physician. After arriving at the airport in Guangzhou, we entered the terminal which is befitting a city of 12,600,000 people. The best word I can find to describe the main building is cavernous. From there we flew to Xi'an.

History is all around you in Xi'an. It was the capital of China under thirteen different dynasties, including the Zhou, Qin, Han, and Tang. Xi'an was also the eastern terminus of the ancient Silk Road and was our starting off point to retrace a bit of that ancient highway ourselves. The city has more than 3,000 years of history and was called Chang'an, literally "Perpetual Peace", in ancient times. The famous Mausoleum of Qin Shi Huang and his terracotta Army are located 40 km to the east of the city's suburbs. The city center is dominated by the Ming dynasty defensive wall. The wall stands 12 meters tall, 12-14 meters wide at the top and 15-18 meters thick at the bottom. It extends for 13.7 kilometers in length and has a deep moat surrounding it. Every 120 meters, there is a rampart which extends out from the main wall. Altogether, there are 98 ramparts on the wall and each rampart has a sentry building, in which the soldiers could protect the entire wall without exposing themselves to the enemy. There is also a fabulous Ming dynasty bell & drum tower at the very center of the city. What is truly amazing is that the old Tang dynasty wall was four times longer in circumference! A couple of wonderful Tang dynasty pagodas are still standing in the city and many Ming and Qing dynasty buildings can be found scattered within the walled city. While there Jim and I took in the Shaanxi History Museum which had a very good collection of Han dynasty mirrors but I have to admit that overall the Provincial Museum was a bit disappointing. Most of the displays were done around 10 years ago, the lighting was abysmal and most rooms had more empty space than displays. Another much more interesting museum was the Yangling Mausoleum of Emperor Jing Yang Di (Liu Qi), Han emperor from 156 BC to 141 BC. This much more modern museum had an underground section where you could view the archeological progress of the dig taking place right in front of you. We were asked to put protective material over our shoes as we actually walked on thick plexiglass over the tomb itself. This tomb complex contained the miniature (1/3 size) terracotta warriors, various livestock, and figures as well as some full size chariots and other items. Many items from the tombs were displayed in a very nice above ground museum.

Coin buying in Xi'an was a bit of a disappointment. I remember 15 years ago, huge strings of Han, Tong and Song dynasty coins everywhere. Now, both in the local market and in shops in town, there was little to buy and prices were no cheaper than here in the West on some occasions, prices were higher. For example, *huo pu* spades of Wang Mang and common Ming knives were selling for RMB150 or US\$19, which is higher than here in the US and we were quoted these same prices from several dealers which indicates that it is the new market price in China. There seems to be promoters within China buying up large quantities of common material for TV or corporate promotion in China. Prices for sycee were much higher than expected everywhere in China, Hong Kong and Macao. I was however able to meet a couple of very nice local dealers who handled genuine coins and did pick up some nice material from them. The local street market was filled with fakes, most easily identifiable as such. Everything imaginable is faked, from Qing dynasty Shaanxi Province multiple cash of Xian Feng to French Indochina piastres even British Churchill crowns and American Eisenhower dollars are faked along with nearly ever type of machine struck Chinese coin, both common and rare. Even the most common Qing dynasty coins are being faked for the tourist market. There is even a selection of bizarre fantasy type crown coins, some with badly blundered English legends. I couldn't figure out to whom the vendors were trying to market these absurdities. All this could frighten away any collector from buying Chinese coins and I admit, I found the shear number and quality of fakes disturbing. Fortunately, Chinese dealers and collectors have a very good system in place to protect each other. My last day in Xi'an I purchased some heavy *wu zhu* coins only to find upon returning to my hotel that the coins were fake. With the help of the local coin don, a Mister Yuan and Roger Doo, we returned to the shop to return the coins. The dealer had already left for the day, so a call was placed and the owner drove and hour back to his shop, where he happily took the items back. While we were waiting for this dealer to return, another dealer who we had dealt with the previous day walked by after closing his shop and mentioned that Jim had left his pen there and he rushed back to his shop to fetch it; this type of honesty in dealers there is rare but not unheard of. It seems that advanced collectors and dealers meet together frequently to get each others opinions on various coins and if one of their own has sold a fake, his reputation is on the line if he does not take back said coin. I saw this system in action on several occasions during the trip and it seems to work well to protect many in China from getting burned with fakes. More to follow... Joe
