Commentary: Our apologies to those who spotted that the Thai Dvaravati tin coin (item #52135) on List 219 was a modern fantasy. We have withdrawn the item from sale. Handling such a wide variety of coins, we occasionally fail to determine that a coin is inauthentic until after we offer it for sale. But we guarantee them, and will always take them back for a full refund. A few years ago, I bought back a fake Russian coin that I had sold, assuming its authenticity, some 20 years before.

In fact, forgeries are an increasing problem, especially in China, where a increasing plethora of fakes, fantasies and pseudo-coins are flooding the market. The fantasy and pseudos are not problematic, as they are readily distinguished from authentic coins and are normally sold very inexpensively. Rather, it is the fakes that are worrisome, as they are surreptitiously pawned off by unscrupulous coin dealers, often at outrageously hefty prices. We must all be vigilant to protect ourselves from the fraudulent suppliers. In the past six months a disturbing number of very high quality counterfeit have been appearing on the market of better Indian gold coins including Kushan, Mughal, and Portuguese Goa. These fakes are good enough to have purchased by knowledgeable dealers and collectors. Be very careful buying any rare coins from Pakistani or Indian sources at the present.

In early December I (Steve) attended a symposium in Shanghai devoted to coins and trade along the Silk Road, part of a broad subject now regarded as "Silk-Roadology". Nearly 40 speakers presented papers dealing with aspects of the Road from ancient times until the 18th century. Modern technology enabled us to listed to each talk in either Chinese or English. My own paper was on the implication of the use of Sasanian and Arab-Sasanian silver drachms along the Silk Road in Xinjiang and Gansu, where close to 2,000 pieces have thus far been recorded. I was concerned with the issues from Khusraw II to the end of Arab-Sasanian period, from roughly 591-700 AD, in particular because so many of the Khusraw II and some of the Arab-Sasanian were clearly contemporary or near-contemporary imitations. I would hypothesize that these imitations were produced either to the east or northeast of Iran, especially Tukharistan and adjacent districts. The Khusraw imitations may have been produced posthumously (after 628) to fulfill the need for silver drachms on the Silk Road, especially in Turfan, where they were widely used until withdrawn about 700. Surprisingly, no post-reform Umayyad dirhams, first struck in 698/699, have been found in Xinjiang excavations.
