Commentary: As our database system grows, we learn new tricks. Most recently, we can now produce **customized lists** for our customers. Items can now be chosen by country, dynasty or mint, but not by denomination, range of dates, catalog numbers, etc. We can separate out gold, but not other metals. However, it is not just a few clicks, and abracadabra we have the list. It can be rather a somewhat more complex sorting process, so that it takes about five-ten minutes to create a PDF list.

However, the sorting process will list every item that appears in our "inventory (active)", which unfortunately can include items that were sold but never properly deleted from active inventory, especially those with item numbers lower than about 45000. Secondly, custom lists include everything in stock, irrespective of where it is filed, so that we usually have to search in numerous places to retrieve all the requested items. This process can take quite a bit of time so we ask that you please order carefully, and if you have questions, best to call us by telephone. Finally, due to the time involved in assembling a lot, coins on custom lists will not be discounted. And finally, coins may be subject to prior sale.

We realize that many of our customers were disappointed to have learned that items they ordered from list #222 had already been sold, even though they had contacted us as quickly as possible after receiving our email announcement that the list was "live" on the website. There were two reasons behind this, one because it took about six hours to send all the emails (computer problem), the other because our printers in Bangalore completed the lists and had them in the mail in just four days, instead of the usual 10-14 days. Some of the earliest emailed or phoned orders were from those who received the list even before we were aware that it had already been posted from Bangalore. Our policy is to send the announcement as soon as we receive the first order from the printed version outside of India. We do not offer the list in advance to favored customers, but once the list is out, it is a "free-for-all". Not everyone wins, just as in Las Vegas. C'est la vie. Our goal is always been and still is to make the ordering process as fair as possible for everyone. If you have any suggestions on how we can improve, please let us know

Due to the large numbers of orders that arrive so quickly, it may take up to a week to ship out all the order, so please be patient.
