After the death of Khusraw II, the Sasanian Empire rapidly collapsed. The first two successors, Kavad II (628) and Ardashir III (628-630), maintained high quality strikes, fully equal to those introduced by Khusraw II about 615. There were several short reign rulers 628-630, most of whose coins retain high quality of strike. Under the final Sasanian ruler, Yazdigerd III (632-651), only during his first three years were coins of high quality struck, all of them extremely rare, with perhaps no more than 20-30 examples known. His coinage at Sijistan (SK) is inferior, though quite common from year 2 to year 20.

Discount Schedule: Remaining coins from price lists 218-227 are now available at **10% discount**, **except** bullion-related items. Serious counteroffers for old stock will be considered.

Show Schedule: Joe and I will have a table at the Santa Clara show, 1-4 November, at the Santa Clara Convention Center on Great America Parkway, then again at the Baltimore show at the Baltimore Convention Center in downtown Baltimore, 15-18 November 2007.

Commentary: At last it is time to announce a major new development in our business, World Numismatic Auctions, with its own website, www.wnauctions.com. Together with Clark Smith of San Rafael, we will be holding an on-line auction of rare coins, scheduled for December 1st and 2nd. Clark will supply gold coins from throughout the world, principally modern, but also some ancient and medieval. Joe and I will supply both gold and other metals, Islamic, Indian, other Asian, and some from elsewhere in the world. We are anticipating a total of between 1000 and 1500 lots in the sale. Our intention is to conduct an auction every year at the beginning of December, and if it is wildly successful, perhaps a second auction during June or July.

We are also accepting consignments of better quality coins that are appropriate for auction. Together, Clark and I have a lengthy list of active collectors and bidders, and we will be promoting our auction through advertising and word-of-mouth. If you are interested in consigning to us, please contact us. We will accept items until the 31st of October.

The auction catalog will be posted in early November on our website, www.wnauctions.com, and a limited number of printed copies will be available upon request. Clark and I will first teach me how to bid, and then we will compose a clear set of instructions clearly explaining how to bid at our on-line auction. These instructions were posted at wnauctions.com, and we will gladly discuss the means of bidding with any of our potential bidders. Over the past several years we have observed the rapidly growing importance of auctions in the numismatic trade, and have chosen to jump on the band-wagon ourselves.

Alas, here is a brief explanation of how posting a price list on the website operates. As soon as we receive the first order from the "snailmailed" list, we notify all our customers by email that the list will be "alive" on the website at a specific time, usually noon the following day Pacific time. If you are not received this email, then we probably don't have your email address on file, so kindly provide us that address (multiple email addresses are OK). You can surely imagine how hectic our office becomes during the first 2 or 3 days after the list is alive on the website --- from list 127 we fulfilled 107 invoices within about 36 hours. It then takes several days to select the coins, pack up the orders and haul them to the post office. We try to email the invoices within a day or so, to inform the customer which of the ordered items were still available. We also update "sold" on the website at least once or twice a day.

We try our best to fill the orders as close as possible to the order of receipt, whether by phone, email, fax or angels from heaven. Orders with special requests are filled on schedule, but held until we have time to pursue those requests, which can be a week later. So patience is appreciated.
